
We received 44 beer ratings sheets. The following list is in rank order with the average score based on a scale of Excellent (4), Good (3), Average (2) and Poor (1).

Fruity</li> <li>• Always great! / Always my favorite</li> <li>• Very excellent! Good go to beer.</li> <li>• Light but still flavorful</li> <li>• Light and tasty</li> <li>• Just so so</li> <li>• Good flavor, love that kind of bite! Easy drinking (could have drunk all night)</li> <li>• Too light</li> <li>• Smooth finish</li> <li>• Very good taste- I like it a lot</li> <li>• Not my fave</li> <li>• Is that apple I taste?  <p>5) Frostbite Winter Ale</p>	<p>3.27</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Liked the hint of spice</li> <li>• Happy to taste one that is not over-spiced. Great!</li> <li>• On the butter side for me</li> <li>• Heavy, very nice</li> <li>• Like the spice! And it's sweet!</li> <li>• Light but with a bite</li> <li>• Very good, kinda girly but has a bold flavor</li> <li>• Nice job! Best winter ale I've had! Not too much alcohol content. Nice! Better Flavor!</li> <li>• Don't usually like darker beers [rated "good"]</li> <li>• Grew on me</li> <li>• I'm a real fan!</li> <li>• Trippel taste</li> <li>• Great flavors, crisp and clean</li> <li>• Nice flavor, smooth, very easy drinking</li> <li>• Fruit punch, unidentified herb</li> <li>• Not too heavy, but a ton of taste.  <p>6) Scottoberfest Stout</p>	<p>3.25</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Not a fan of stout but very "roasty"</li> <li>• Bitter, Rich, Smooth...Everything Scottoberfest is ☺</li> <li>• So amazing! Yum.</li> <li>• Tons of malt, really delicious stout</li> <li>• Beautiful beer. Pitch black lights out beer</li> <li>• Dark, hoppy. I like dark!</li> <li>• Smooth- great signature</li> <li>• Way too dark for me – one sip and I dumped it out</li> <li>• Not what I expected, had a little weird flavor</li> <li>• Not as good as the porter though...</li> <li>• Fantastic stout</li> <li>• Delicious</li> <li>• Nice strong flavor, strong after-bite</li> </ul>
 <p>7) Stock Ale</p>	<p>3.11</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Every day yummy</li> <li>• Stalky</li> <li>• Light and tasty</li> <li>• Another great beer, very good flavor</li> <li>• Surprisingly loved the sour taste and the alcohol content was masked well.</li> <li>• Delightful, fruity, crisp, nice finish</li> <li>• Crisp, little bitter aftertaste</li> </ul>

 <p>8) Drunk &amp; Wise Dunkelwiezen</p>	<p>3.034</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Meh</li> <li>• Not my favorite style, but better than most</li> <li>• Little bit sour for my liking</li> <li>• This beer means business</li> <li>• I like the beginning taste, after taste not so much</li> <li>• Too many flavors. A little extreme. I did like the beginning of a sip but not the end</li> <li>• Good but carbonated</li> <li>• Fruit and malt</li> <li>• Hit at first sip</li> <li>• Licorice? Anise? Great stuff</li> <li>• Fruity</li> <li>• Perfect, great taste! Crisp and not bitter.</li> <li>• Very bright flavor, ends on a high note</li> </ul>
 <p>9) Pudgy Porter</p>	<p>3.031</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• More fruit/flower flavor than expecting...Pudgy Porter should be rich</li> <li>• Nice flavor, a bit more carbonation than I'm used to</li> <li>• OK</li> <li>• Good, but not "[illegible word- possibly sweet]" enough</li> <li>• Nice spices! Flavorful and super robust</li> <li>• Like the flavor mix</li> <li>• Very distinct flavor, I really like this one</li> <li>• Love the balance and chocolate! The better parts of Surly Bender and Coffee Bender</li> <li>• A little sweet</li> <li>• Great unique flavor and scent</li> <li>• A surprise hit</li> <li>• Very smooth, reminded me of Blue Moon</li> <li>• Outstanding dessert beer</li> <li>• Smooth, nice sweet/mild aftertaste- great flavor</li> <li>• Taste explosion!!</li> </ul>

 <p>10) Roggenbier</p>	<p>2.96</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Subtle with a soft bite at the end...Tough Guy's baby bro</li> <li>• Excellent spicy rye malt character, light color</li> <li>• A fine beer</li> <li>• Spunky</li> <li>• Not a fan of the rye flavor</li> <li>• Kinda sweet with a little bite, good beverage</li> <li>• Too bubbly with a lot of hops and fruit / Too strong and bitter – not good</li> <li>• Good but odd aftertaste</li> <li>• Refreshing</li> <li>• Great hops, refreshing</li> <li>• Nice and dry – good finish</li> <li>• Surprisingly delicious</li> <li>• Very bitter</li> <li>• Bubbly, hoppy, bright</li> </ul>
 <p>11) Dubliner Red Lager</p>	<p>2.86</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dublin is a great description...Irish eyes are smiling</li> <li>• Is it smoky?</li> <li>• Am I tasting caramel? Maybe?</li> <li>• Red October</li> <li>• Lovely! Like it a lot</li> <li>• A bit watery</li> <li>• Too much for me – after taste</li> <li>• I liked it but wouldn't drink much of it</li> <li>• Missed the color - A little too hoppy for a lager</li> <li>• Nice!</li> <li>• Feisty</li> <li>• Yes!</li> <li>• Strong burnt corn aftertaste</li> </ul>
